Sue Hinton called today with adjustments and additions to the schedule for the 2017 season. Items marked “***” are new, or revised. Dates with question marks (??) indicate the arrangements are not yet confirmed. The other items within () are my comments.

Practices:

Except as noted below, I did not receive any new information on the practice schedule. The routine practices are held at the Hallsville School House and begin at 7:30pm.

Performances:

August 5 – 11:30am for the Ross County Fair horse racing.

Admission is free on the 5th. Glenn suggests parking as close to the Commercial Building as you can.

August 6 – 11:30am for the Ross County Fair horse racing.

Admission is charged on the 6th. Glenn will be passing out tickets on Saturday to cover the cost of entering the fairgrounds on Sunday.

August 28 – Rhoads Garden Center, 1051 OH-56, Circleville, OH 43113.

There will be a cookout at 6:30pm. Practice will follow.

September 9 – Hallsville Fun Day. Concert at 1pm.

Held at the park on the eastern edge of Hallsville.

September 16 – Adelphi Car Show & Dedication of the Town Hall. Concert at 1pm.

September 23 - ?? Jackson Apple Festival ?? Appearance not yet confirmed.

(In recent years we have performed in the parade at 7:45pm.)

October 13 – 11:30am for the Fairfield County Fair horse races, Lancaster.

October 20 – 8pm Circleville Pumpkin Show parade

October 21 – 7pm concert at the Circleville Pumpkin Show.

(In 2016 the concert was held at 6pm at the Visitor’s Pavilion.)

(“***” The Pumpkin Show Band was recently informed the Visitor’s Pavilion was no longer going to host musical groups. As result, the concert location is yet to be confirmed. “***”)

October 21 - 8pm Circleville Pumpkin Show parade.
