

# Ross Fair Closes Out Tonight

Saturday, the final day of the 1968 Ross County Fair, will be highlighted by the Stoney Roberts Demolition Derby at the grandstand.

The show, which always draws a large crowd, will begin at 8 p.m., according to J. K. Rudell, fair board treasurer.

Mr. Rudell says that attendance at Friday's fair was below last year's figure.

There were 4,100 paid admissions Friday, down 300 from Friday last year.

The Adelphi Band is the featured band at Saturday's fair. They will play at 7 p.m. at the grandstand, following an afternoon performance at the bandstand.

The 4-H awards presentation will take place at 6 p.m. at the junior fair building. It will be followed by a junior fair board-sponsored dance at 8:30 p.m. in the junior fair building.
