**Front To Be Presented By  
G. O. P. In Ross County  
This Fall.**

**COMMITTEE  
ORGANIZED  
And Get Ready To Start  
On Campaign In  
Earnest.**

In pursuance of a call issued by Chairman C. A. Davenport of the Ross County Central Committee a meeting of that body was held in this city this morning. The meeting proved to be one of the most harmonious political gatherings held in Ross county for years, portending harmony of action all around and a united front to elect the entire ticket from top to bottom—a realization divinely to be wished by every true Republican citizen and many who have hitherto held opposite views.

The call had been issued for the purpose of organizing and of selecting an executive or campaign committee in the office at E. A. Tucker's office at 11 o'clock. Prior to that time a meeting was held in H. P. Maulier's office at which addresses were given by Mr. Maulier and Frank Redfern, while others discussed the great possibilities which would flow from a united front to the opposition this fall.

A ticket was framed and presented to the caucus and objections had called for, but none were made and thereupon the caucus adjourned to meet later in Mr. Tucker's office.
