## Fair Ends Friday

### Special Fireworks Will Climax Events Of "Chillicothe Day"

Ross county's second annual fair will wind up in a blaze of fireworks—a 45-minute display—Friday night, climaxing the many special events of the "Chillicothe Day" program.

Detailed program for the big day was announced Thursday by Robert Barnhart, who heads the Chamber of Commerce program committee for the day.

"Anyone who hasn't seen the fair is urged to do so on Friday," Mr. Barnhart said. "The committee has a splendid general program arranged and throughout the day announcements will be made regularly over the public address system to inform the people of various other activities on the grounds. Chillicothe's retail merchants, who have provided the fireworks which terminate each day's program, have a very special display for presentation as the closing feature."

- 3:30 p. m.—C. H. S. band concert at the race track.
- 4:30 p. m.—Leggett Baby parade, led by Dr. C. D. Leggett and the Adelphi band from the race track.
