

Stoutsville Planning Big Labor Day Celebration

Although the Firemen's Labor Day celebration in Stoutsville doesn't officially open until 7 p.m. Friday, Sept. 4, the fish stand opens at 4 p.m., and entries of crafts, flowers and canned goods will be accepted at the K.P. Hall from 4-6 p.m., and vegetables from 5:30-7:30 p.m.

From 6-11 p.m. rides will be available on a "ride as many times as you want for one price" basis. The Little Miss and Mr. Firefighter parade is at 6:30, and the judging of Little Miss and Mr. Firefighter is at 7:15. Dixieland music by the "Sounds of Music" is scheduled from 8-11 p.m.

Saturday, Sept. 5, men's all-day softball games begin at 9 a.m., and entries of baked goods may be submitted from 11 a.m.-noon. From 2 p.m. there are the

mini-tractor pull and the big wheel race, and the Miss Firefighter parade at 5 p.m.; judging of Miss Firefighter at 6; and round and square dancing with "Cross Fire," 7:30-10:30 p.m.

Sunday, Sept. 6, begins with an open church service in front of the firehouse at 11 a.m., and the festival opens at noon with softball games and lunch served at the firehouse.

In the afternoon there will be gospel singing, a firemen's water battle behind the firehouse, Outstanding Citizen and Firemen of the Year Award at 2 p.m., sack race and bubble gum contest beginning at 6 p.m., and a talent contest at 7:30.

Roast beef dinners will be served from noon-7:30 p.m.
