

Village Field Day begins Thursday

CLARKSBURG — Plans have been completed for the 67th Clarksburg Field Day Thursday at the Field Day Grounds, ¼ mile east of the village on Ohio 138. It is sponsored annually by the United Methodist Church and in the past large crowds have been attracted to the all-day and evening event. This year's co-chairmen are Vernon "Butch" Alexander and Charles Wood.

The morning activities begin with trap-shooting, horseshoe pitching and a flea market.

The Adelphi Band, which has appeared for more than 50 years on the Field Day programs, will highlight the afternoon entertainment giving two concerts. The Adena Band, with the Adena Junior Twilers, also will present a concert.

Children's games and contests, scheduled to begin at 3 p.m., will end with the greased pole climb. The Deerfield Emergency Technicians will give a demonstration at 4:30 followed by Doug Jones, country singer, of Chillicothe.

Other entertainers for the evening include Country Knights of Washington Court House, Tad Free, guitarist of Chillicothe, and the featured group, Uhrig Brothers Quartet, Gospel singers of Chillicothe, who will present a two-hour program beginning at 6:30 p.m.

FISH AND chicken dinners will be served beginning at 4:30 and fish, other sandwiches and refreshments will be available during the day and evening.
