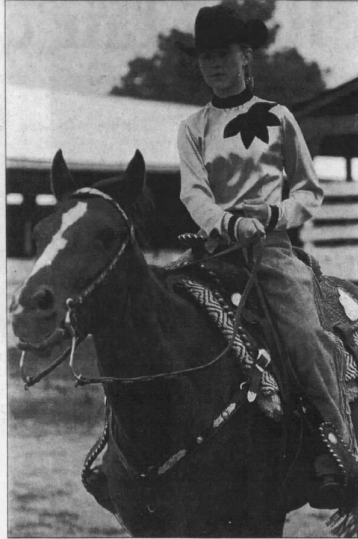


Highlights
