Hallsville festival opens tonight

HALLSVILLE — Smoke from the black powder shoot should send out signals to Ross Countians that it's time for the Hallsville Indian Summer Festival.

The 12th annual festival gets underway tonight with a parade at 5:30. It will be followed with an opening ceremony and princess contest at the festival grounds off Ohio 180 in Hallsville. The little brave and little Princess contest will be held Friday night.

Other highlights of the four-day festival, which ends late Sunday, include an ongoing flea market, a night of rock music, some square dancing and fireworks. And to keep the pow-wow from overheating, area firefighters will be dousing each other in a water battle.
