Hallsville festival starts Thursday

Hallsville's eighth annual Indian Summer Festival is set for Thursday through Sunday on the Russel Jones farm off Jackson Street in Hallsville.

The festival began in 1975 when community residents recognized the need for a youth-oriented facility. Now that the Hallsville Community Center is a realization, proceeds from the festival go toward the payment and development of a 6.4-acre park on Ohio 180. To date, the park has picnic facilities and a ball diamond. A shelterhouse is being planned. When the site is developed, residents plan to hold the festival at the park as well.

Highlighting this year's activities is the traditional hog roast, Thursday-Saturday, and Saturday bread baking by the 1001 Scaggs Army Reserve Unit of Chillicothe. Reserves take all equipment necessary to bake the bread on the grounds. A sunrise breakfast, followed by a worship service, is planned for Sunday and a three-day flea market will close Sunday at 7 p.m.

Parades are scheduled for Thursday and Friday. Sunday, the Buckeye State Harmonica Club will host a contest.

Taking care of this year's Indian Summer Festival is Jones, festival chairman, and Bob Anderson, president of the Hallsville Community Center.
