

Clarksburg Field Day scheduled

The 67th Clarksburg Field Day, sponsored annually by the United Methodist Church, will be held August 5 at the Field Day Grounds, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of the village on S R. 138. Vernon "Dutch" Alexander and Charles Wood are co-chairmen of the all-day and evening event.

The morning activities begin with trap shooting, horseshoe pitching and flea market. The widely-known Adelphi Band will feature the afternoon program giving two concerts. They have appeared on the programs here for more than 50 years. The Adena Band, with Adena Junior Twirlers, will also present a concert.

Children's games and contests are scheduled to begin at 3 p.m. ending with the greased pole. A demonstration by the Deerfield Emergency Technicians will be given at 4:30 followed by Doug Jones, country singer, of Chillicothe.
