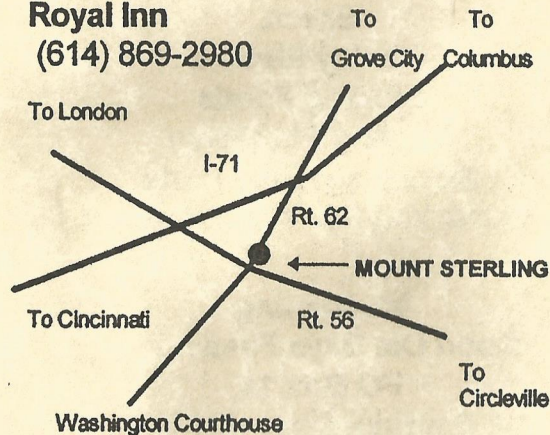
Parking is available in adjacent areas. Food and beverages will be available throughout the weekend as well. For those wishing to stay overnight, you can contact:

5. If you break down, please ask for help and move to the side of the road to allow the rest of the parade to continue.
6. Political entries must pay a \$25.00 entry fee to participate.
7. Whenever possible, we encourage old time dress.
