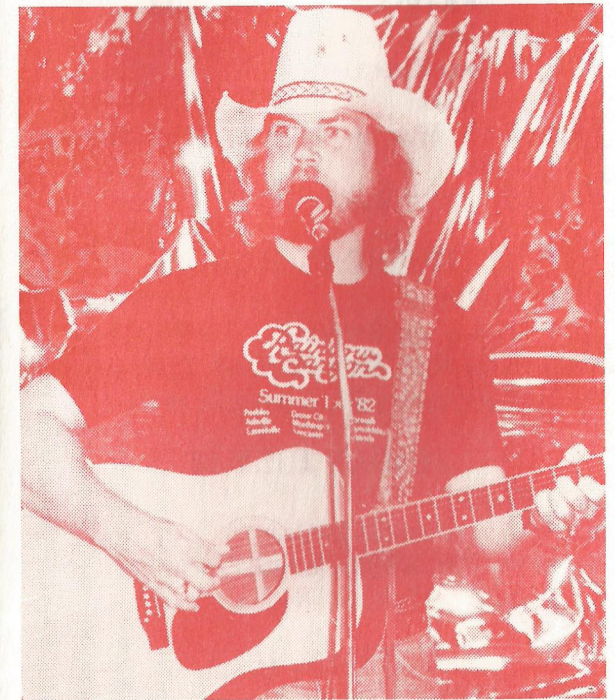


# FIREMAN'S OLD TIME FESTIVAL

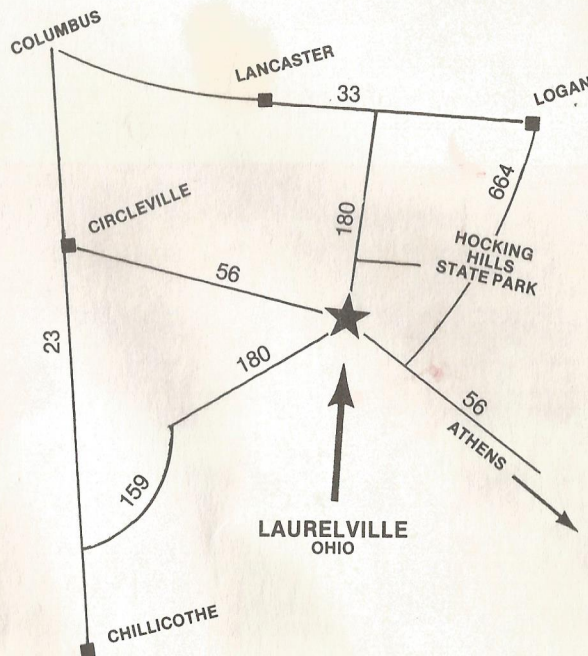
