

TEXT DESCRIPTION:

1	The Hallsville Cemetery is apparently called “ Maple Grove Cemetery ” for those who may use Google Maps, or some other map program, to find it. But, Google Maps will certainly find it if you just put in “Hallsville, Ohio cemetery”
2	It is located on the WEST side of Hallsville, and on the SOUTH side of Route 180.
3	It is on the corner of Route 180 and Walnut Creek Road.

FOR THOSE OF YOU UNSURE HOW TO GET TO HALLSVILLE:

1	Coming out of Circleville, take Rt 56 EAST
2	Once you drive <u>past</u> the Circleville Dairy Shed (<i>the happiest place on earth</i>) going out of Circleville at the intersection of Kingston Pike and Route 56, you will STAY on Route 56. You will then pass: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a). a 4-way stop. b). a 4-way stop at the intersection of Rt 56 and Route 159. c) Another 4-way stop, and 4). Just before you come into Laurelville, you will round a corner going to your left, and Rt 180 will come into RT 56 from the RIGHT. There isn't any stop sign on Route 56 at the intersection of Route 180 and Route 56. <p><i>HINT: From the Circleville Dairy Shed, it is @ 13.9 miles into Adelphi</i></p>
3	Turn RIGHT on to Rt 180 and go up the hill into Adelphi. <p>You will come to another 4-way stop at Adelphi at an intersection where a there is a large bar on the LEFT side. It is called “Alibi's Bar and Grill”.</p>
4	Turn RIGHT on Route 180. The Hallsville Cemetery will be @ 5.4 miles from that point.
5	Should you need “something” that early in the morning, or even after the ceremony, you could miss the turn to 180 going into Adelphi and go straight into Laurelville. There you would find a: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. gas station (<i>should be open, and is the only gas station for several miles</i>) 2. a grocery store (<i>should be open</i>) 3. And a Family Dollar (<i>should be open</i>).

FOR PARKING, CHECK THE NEXT PAGES:

There are 2 basic areas you can park at the Hallsville Cemetery:

1	<p>Right inside the entrance off of Route 180.</p> <p>There is a huge grassy area on both sides of the driveway there which will hold more cars than will ever be at the cemetery that date.</p>
2	<p>Because you guys will be getting there earlier than most spectators, you should be able to drive past that parking area and go up farther into the cemetery.</p> <p>Where we will be playing is at the tall monument on the RIGHT, surrounded by some trees, in the center of the cemetery.</p> <p>Just in front of you (LEFT) as you drive up inside the cemetery, and directly across from the monument, will be a large grassy area with a small concrete pad. This will accommodate several cars. Park on the grass.</p> <p>You should be able to find a spot to park there, which will be a little closer to the monument and the area where we will play than parking just inside the cemetery as you come off of Route 180.</p> <p>HINT: it is an uphill walk from the grassy area just off of Route 180.</p> <p>But it is still shorter and less steep than the route your parents told you they had to walk every day to go to school...so there's that.</p>
